FAITH ON THE WAY

Worksheet 3A: Planning to implement

Planning

For the group that is to be responsible for implementing and overseeing the process of 'On the Way' in the parish. It could be a committee of the church council or a specially formed task group.

Preparation

Read Chapter 4 of Faith on the Way (and Chapters 1 to 3, if you have not already done so).

Task

There are four main items of work. It may take two sessions to complete them.

- 1. Review: What has happened since the last meeting? What decisions have been taken by the relevant bodies in your church? Are you ready to proceed?
- 2. You have agreed to start 'Faith on the Way'. Who are the actual people you will be accompanying on their journey?
 - (a) Is there already someone asking about confirmation? Are there people on the fringes of church membership that you should be inviting to join?
 - (b) Are there church leaders, clergy and others you should ask for names of possible candidates?
 - (c) What groups or individuals should you contact for possible people?
 - (d) Should you advertise that the process is beginning? How? In the church magazine? Give it out in church? On the notice board, in the local press, on local radio?
- 3. The team: Who have you in mind as possible group leaders and sponsors? What part do you expect the clergy to play? What training do leaders and sponsors need before they begin?
- 4. What pattern of group working seems most appropriate for your place? What part do you expect the sponsors to play in the groups? Do you want to link sponsors one-to-one with candidates or not? (See the section 'Accompanied' on pp. 51-2 of *Faith on the Way*.)
- 5. Timetable: Should you make diary dates, pencilling in:
 - (a) Training sessions for team members?
 - (b) First meeting of the group(s)?
 - (c) Possible date for a Service of Welcome?
 - (d) Possible date for the Service of God's Call?
 - (e) Possible date for baptism and confirmation?
- 6. What about the place of the bishop in the process? What consultations need to take place with the bishop about dates, etc.?
